ANNUAL MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

BONDED SEAT BUTTERFLY VALVES (FOR STANDARD SERVICE):

- 1. CYCLE VALVE TO VERIFY OPERATION AND NO INTERFERENCE IN LINE.
- CLOSE VALVE AND CHECK FOR LEAKAGE. IF LEAKAGE IS DETECTED, CHECK OPERATOR STOPS TO VERIFY THAT DISC IS FULLY CLOSED. IF LEAKAGE PERSISTS, REMOVE VALVE TO INSPECT SEAT. A DAMAGED SEAT REQUIRES VALVE TO BE RETURNED TO THE FACTORY FOR REPAIR.
- 3. CHECK FLANGE CONNECTIONS FOR LEAKAGE. TIGHTEN BOLTS ACCORDINGLY.
- 4. CHECK TOP TRUNNION AREA FOR SHAFT LEAKAGE. IF LEAKAGE IS DETECTED, REPLACE VALVE PACKING.

NOTE: 10" AND LARGER VALVES HAVE TOP AND BOTTOM PACKING.

NOTE: LUBRICATION IS NOT REQUIRED.

BONDED SEAT BUTTERFLY VALVES (FOR BURIED SERVICE):

1. CYCLE VALVE TO VERIFY OPERATION AND NO INTERFERENCE IN LINE. LISTEN FOR LEAKAGE IN CLOSED POSITION

NOTE: LUBRICATION IS NOT REQUIRED.
